



Residential Care ranges in cost from \$ 400.00 - \$2,000.00BZD Monthly Average cost per geriatric patient in the NHI System is 30X higher than average There remains a shortage in trained caregivers and high cost private caregiving services










Belize PLHIV Estimate: 3515 (3500)
